# Benefits of Safety Technology Elude Construction Sector

Technology could help address the growing problem of construction workers killed by falls, but the industry has been slower than others to adopt its use, says an attorney. But, "Construction seems to be somewhat immune to the impact of technology," said Mr. Boulé, who spoke at a session on fatal falls in the industry at the 2017 CLM & Business Insurance Construction Conference in San Diego on Tuesday.

The industry "has not benefited much from automation, which can engineer out some of the unsafe activities workers engage in," he said. "Probably cost is the number one reason why technology has not drifted into the construction industry" to the same extent it has in other industries, he said. He noted that over the past five years, deaths at construction sites have increased 26%, while there has been a 36% increase in deaths as a result of falls. Read Article <u>HERE</u>
