Hand signals are used during operations of cranes, lifts, backing equipment and at times, when distance and verbal communications are impacted as a means of safe direct communication. Hazcom labels and the understanding of these labels are required by OSHA. *Print* today's attachments and *post* at your break rooms and job sites. *Hold a safety meeting* to discuss the requirements and perhaps even have a test or contest to learn the requirements. It can save a life or limb. *(Print, Post, Hold a Safety Meeting!)*
