### 1. Project & Bidding information

The West Texas *AGC Newsletter and Project List* sent by email or accessed online each Thursday provides complete information on projects available to bid, i.e. scope of work, bid dates and time, A & E or CM to contact, bidders list, bid tabulations and contract awards. The *Update* issued the other 4 weekdays, provide notices of new projects and related information i.e. addenda and bid date changes.

### 2. Internet Plan Room and Physical Plan Room Services

Our **internet plan room service** provides accurate and prompt information on projects throughout the chapter territory and beyond for building, industrial, roadway, utility, maintenance and supply projects. Available 24/7 from internet access. This on-line access to projects, plans, specifications and bidder information is a benefit of your West Texas AGC membership **at no additional subscription fee.**

WTAGC has 4 **physical plan room offices** available to provide reprographic services, review projects by hard copy or on-line through computer access. Plan rooms are equipped with a member use computer, estimating desks, copiers, wide and standard office supplies. Plans may be reserved for overnight or for week-end check-out.

### 3. Employer Policy & Manual

Each new member is provided with an Employer Policy and Procedures manual customized with your company name. Information includes policies on: a Corporate Safety, FMLA, Theft and Vandalism, Equal Opportunity, standard posters required for jobsites, and examples for company policies for drug or alcohol testing or sexual harassment to name just a few. Available on CD for further customizing and to fit your company needs.

### 4. Legislative Resources

Membership with the chapter includes membership to the State and National AGC organizations resulting in a direct link and access to the important construction issues happening at the State Capital and in Washington D. C. AGC Lobbyists look out for the interests of the construction industry, keeping you abreast of the issues, giving you a voice and opportunity to be involved. An Advocacy site on our web page with Legislation and Politics that impact our industry keeps you informed.

### 5. Membership Discounts

There are over 25 dividend and saving programs for our members through the Chapter or AGC of America.
