Daily Reminders - What you need know and do about COVID 19

STOP THE SPREAD OF GERMS

Help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases like COVID-19.

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick, except to get medical care.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

Coalition suggests changes to coronavirus OSHA reporting rules

AGC and other members of the Construction Industry Safety Coalition have written a [letter](#) to OSHA suggesting the agency change its stance on coronavirus reporting to treat the virus like the common cold or the flu and consider cases an exception to geographic presumption of work-relatedness. The coalition also suggests maintaining separate case logs or having reporting requirements apply only to situations in which an employee contracts the coronavirus by providing direct medical treatment to a person with a confirmed diagnosis.
