



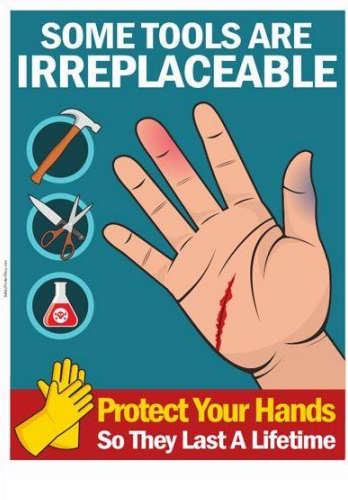

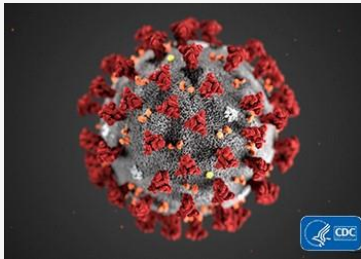

### Bidder Be Thoughtful: The Impacts of Disclaimers in Pre-Bid Reports

When bidding a project, ***subsurface or latent site conditions that are not immediately apparent can massively impact the costs of performance to general contractors and sub-contractors.*** Were contractors required to bid on projects without any information on pre-existing conditions, they would need either to be assured that any additional costs would be reimbursed by the owner, or to include significant contingencies for subsurface conditions in their bids. For owners, these options result in either increased risk or increased cost—neither of which is particularly palatable. Owners therefore implement several contractual tools to minimize these risks and costs.
