OSHA will update this guidance over time to reflect developments in science, best practices, and standards.



Click for **Summary of changes August 13, 2021**

This guidance is designed to help employers protect workers who are unvaccinated (including people who are not fully vaccinated) or otherwise at-risk (as defined in the text box below), including if they are immunocompromised, and also implement new guidance involving workers who are fully vaccinated but located in <u>areas of substantial or high community transmission</u>. The majority if not all counties in the West Texas AGC Chapter area are in the 'Red' high transmission area.

OSHA emphasizes that vaccination is the most effective way to protect against severe illness or death from COVID-19.


