2026 Build West Texas Awards

**All entries must be received no later than
5:00pm on January 9, 2026.**

Project submissions by West Texas AGC members will be considered. General Contractor category submissions must have been reported on annual revenue reports.

Projects achieving Substantial Completion in the calendar year 2025 will be eligible.

Projects will be recognized in 15 categories. Projects will be recognized as Gold, Silver, and Bronze award winners. Project/s receiving the highest score will be recognized as the Platinum winner. Companies may only submit one project per category.

- Platinum – project/s receiving highest
- Gold – projects receiving scores >90
- Silver – projects receiving scores from 80-89
- Bronze – projects receiving scores from 70-79

Project submissions are to be submitted from December 1, 2025 until January 9, 2026. All submissions will be judged by a 3rd party panel of construction experts. All submissions are to be submitted electronically. No hard copies will be accepted. All submissions must follow the requirements listed in the Project Submission Requirements.

All documents within this packet are a template for the information required for each project submitted.

Submission Fee: \$250.00 per project.

Submissions are not complete and will not be judged without payment. Payments are due no later than January 16, 2026.

Project Submission Requirements

- Project must have achieve Substantial Completion in 2025.
- Project must have been reported to West Texas AGC for 2025 calendar year.
- Project Narrative
 - Narrative must be submitted in .pdf format.
 - Project narrative is limited to 10 pages for projects less than \$10,000,000.00, 20 pages for projects greater than \$10,000,000.00.
 - Project narrative should be in one, single column, vertical on page, to be submitted in portrait format.
 - Photos may be incorporated in narrative to illustrate purpose.
 - Do not use watermarks in the submission.
 - Scanned documents will not be accepted.
 - Narrative submissions should not exceed 5mb.
- Safety Narrative
 - Narrative must be submitted in .pdf format.
 - Safety narrative should be in one, single column, vertical on page, to be submitted in portrait format.
 - Photos may be incorporated in narrative to illustrate purpose.
 - Do not use watermarks in the submission.
 - Scanned documents will not be accepted.
- Subcontractor and Suppliers List
 - List must be submitted in .xls or .xlsx format.
 - Submission should note all subcontractors and suppliers who are members of a Texas AGC chapter. The list must note membership for each subcontractor and supplier with a YES or NO.
 - Bonus points will be awarded based on the percentage of West Texas AGC members.
- Project Photos
 - Each submission should include 3 high resolution, digital photographs.
 - Photos must be submitted in .jpeg format.
 - Each photo should be submitted in landscape format.



Project Judging Guidelines

- Project Narrative
 - Difficulty in construction resulting from design, location, materials, etc.
 - Unusual construction techniques involved
 - Final appearance and quality of the finished product
 - Timeliness of completion
 - Completed within budget
- Safety Narrative
 - Describe the safety programs utilized during the completion of this project in 500 words or less.
- Subcontractors and Suppliers List
 - Sample format below should be used.
 - Do not submit .pdf file.
