2026 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

A. Eligibility

- a. The applicant shall be a 2026 Spring semester high school graduate, or a current college undergraduate, or be working in the construction industry in the West Texas Chapter territory. Scholarships are for individuals pursuing two-year or four-year degree plans or an approved technical trades school in a construction-related field.
- b. Applicant shall be a U. S. citizen or be a documented permanent resident of the United States.
- c. Tuition Assistance Scholarship – applicants are eligible to receive scholarship multiple times as long as all other criteria are met.
- d. Technical School Tool Purchase Scholarship – applicants are eligible to receive tool purchase scholarship one time.

B. Requirements – Applicant is responsible for ensuring the following items are submitted as one package by **March 31, 2026.**

- a. Complete application.
- b. A copy of ACT, SAT, or TSI A2 Scores.
- c. A current copy of high school or college transcript of academic records.
- d. Minimum of two letters of recommendation from teachers or faculty members.
- e. Essay stating why the applicant is pursuing a construction education and/or career (two pages maximum).
- f. Applicant shall be a U. S. citizen or be a documented permanent resident of the United States.
- g. Preference shall be given to a relative or member of the West Texas AGC Chapter or an employee of a member. That member shall have been an active member of the Chapter for two years prior to the application.
- h. Additional Considerations:
 - i. Financial assistance needs.
 - ii. Qualities of good character and integrity.

C. Awards

- a. Scholarships will be made after April 30, 2026. These are annual awards per student, and any subsequent award will be based upon subsequent application and competition.
- b. The student applicant shall agree that the use of funds awarded shall be predicated on his or her enrollment or continuance of education in a recognized and/or accredited school as may be acceptable to the Awards Committee. The approved funds should be used for such purposes as tuition fees, books, and student school supplies.
- c. Applications will be reviewed, and selections made by the Scholarship Committee and approved by the West Texas AGC Executive Committee.
- d. Checks made to the scholarship recipient and college/school will be mailed to the winners in August preceding the school year.
