

## West Texas AGC Scholarship Committee Guidelines and Parameters

The applicant shall be a 2026 Spring semester high school graduate, or a current college undergraduate, or be working in the construction industry in the West Texas Chapter territory. Scholarships are for individuals pursuing two-year or four-year degree plans or a technical trade school certification or degree. All programs must be in a construction related field.

Applicant is responsible for ensuring the following items are submitted as one package and postmarked by Due Date:

- 1. Complete application.
- 2. A copy of ACT, SAT, or TSI A2 Scores.
- 3. A copy of high school transcript or most recent college transcript.
- 4. Minimum of two letters of recommendation from teachers or faculty members.
- 5. Essay stating why the applicant is pursuing a construction education and/or career (two pages maximum).
- 6. Applicant shall be a U. S. citizen or be a documented permanent resident of the United States.
- 7. Preference shall be given to a relative or member of the West Texas AGC Chapter or an employee of a member. That member shall have been an active member of the Chapter for two years prior to the application.
- 8. Additional Considerations:
  - a. Financial assistance needs.
  - b. Qualities of good character and integrity.

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED

## **Parameters for Scholarship Review Committee**

Scholarships should be a minimum of \$500.00 to a maximum of \$2,500.00 for individual applicants. The Executive Committee will review parameters and increase or decrease these values based on the income of the annual Golf Tournament, Clay Shoot, and the Chapter Scholarship Fund. Awards are given annually to students who are pursuing a career in construction through technical trade, or two-year or four-year degrees in construction related programs, including architecture and engineering.
